

The Coalition Government at Westminster have [announced changes to the support available to people affected by contaminated blood](#) - especially those affected by Hepatitis C.

Although these changes were announced in England the Devolved Governments in [Scotland](#), Wales and N Ireland have all agreed to take part in the new arrangements.

The Public Health Minister, [Anne Milton MP](#), has now agreed to review the [Skipton Fund stage 2 criteria](#) and to respond to the [Penrose Inquiry](#) when it reports.
