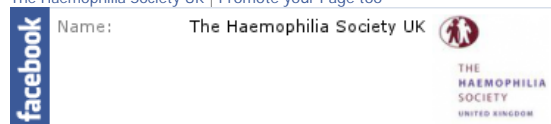
While obviously that is a good thing it does mean that it is harder for people to support each other.
